An EMA electrical engineer/technician can be considered as one of the "T" for grades L3 to L5. For ME08, one of the technical personnel with NTC2 in electrical trade can be considered for L1 to L5. For ME10, a holder of NTC2 in electrical trade can be considered for L1. Two holders of NTC2 in electrical trade can be considered for L2.
