A GOOD QUESTION REQUIRES RESEARCH (NOT JUST REFLECTION OR OPINION) AND IS NARROW ENOUGH TO ALLOW FOR AN ANSWER. HERE ARE SOME KINDS OF QUESTIONS ONE SHOULD GENERALLY TRY TO AVOID. COMMON PROBLEMS IN QUESTION POSING 1.
